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### **Recent Email Message from AACPM/ASPA Regarding Affiliation**




# American Academy of Certified Public Managers ®

Our Society is affiliated with the American Academy of Certified Public Managers<sup>®</sup> which is now a Chapter of the American Society for Public Administration.

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
