Committee Reports

Elections Committee: No report.

Membership Committee: Society has 65 AACPM members and 19 KSCPM Life members only.

Program Committee: President Woods thanked the Program Committee for a job well done on today's luncheon. Cassidy discussed the upcoming Fall Luncheon regarding

Dr. Aaron Thompson Speaks at Summer Luncheon

The Kentucky Society of Certified Public Managers® (KSCPM) held its summer speaker luncheon July 12 on the campus of Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond. KSCPM members at the Department of Criminal Justice Training were the hosts for this annual event.



Dr. Aaron Thompson, the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs, Kentucky Council on Postsecondary Education was the guest speaker. Dr. Thompson serves as the Chief Academic Officer for higher education in the state of Kentucky. He provides oversight and management for a variety of programs linking the academic programs of Kentucky's postsecondary institutions with a public agenda addressing the needs of students, citizens, and of Kentucky's communities and economy. In addition, as Senior Vice President he is responsible for managing and ensuring that Kentucky Adult Education and Technology and Elearning initiatives directly contribute towards Kentucky's overall education and postsecondary goals.

Dr. Thompson spoke about "What creates a successful leader?"

- The main job of a leader is to build good leaders
- To be a good leader you must have discipline
- Are you as a leader with the right organization

Dr. Thompson concluded his presentation by emphasizing the importance of leaders surrounding themselves with good people, and then answered questions from the audience. After the drawing for door prizes for the luncheon table decorations provided by the Program Committee, the meeting was adjourned and attendees spent some time meeting people and talking to colleagues.
